Course of Study	Occupational Course of Study (OCS)	Standard Diploma
Description	The OCS track is designed to teach students essential work skills to help them transition effectively into the workplace. This course of study focuses on more functional mathematics and electives. It features reduced academic requirements to allow for job training and off campus work time. This track is well suited for individuals who struggle with academics or learn at a slower pace. We currently only offer two of the electives (Occupational Prep I and Occupational Prep II) afterschool. Students are required to attend these courses as well as a summer camp.	The standard diploma track is for students who are academically on track with traditional grade level expectations. The course material is more rigorous than the OCS program. Students may be able to participate in the Career and College Promise Program through GTCC.
